Develop effective means for responding to accidents or emergencies thereby avoiding or minimising environmental damage.

Provide appropriate environmental Training for all employees and actively promote and encourage the pursuit of environmental excellence not only within the company itself but also through its suppliers and customers.

Carry out regular environmental audits of all aspects of the companies business both to ensure effective implementation of environmental policy and lessen the risk of operational failure which might lead to environmental damage.
